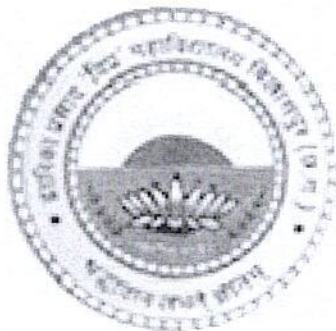

Establishment : D. P. Vipra College was established as a night college on 1st July, 1969. The strength of the students then was 107. Those who have significant contribution in the establishment of the college are mainly, *late Shri Rameshwar Prasad Sharma* who was a strong politician and an irrigation minister in the government of M.P. , *Shri Amarnath Sao*, a social worker, *late Shri Dwarika Prasad Tiwari 'Vipra'*, a dedicated personality to the Chhattisgarhi Literature and culture, *late Shri Ramakant Mishra*, a great scholar of culture and eminent jurist of the city, *late Padm Shri Pt. Shyamlal Chaturvedi*, a journalist, dedicated to literature, music and culture and former chairman of Official Language Commission, *Shri Rajkumar Agrawal*, a hard working enthusiastic social worker, *Shri Nandkishore Tiwari*, a progressive thinker, dedicated to the Chhattisgarhi Literature, *Professor Ramnarayan Shukla*, founder Principal and former Chairman of the administration committee, a dedicated personality to the development of education, *Shri G.P. Kaushik* and *Shri Subhash Mishra*, Leagalists, and rich in development thinking, *Dr. Sheela Tiwari*, former Principal, a supporter of girls' education and an active educationalist, *Shri Narendra Kachhuwaha*, a businessman, *Shri Anurag Shukla*, Chairman of the present administration committee, a belligerent personality, the carrier of the rich technical and nature-friendliness of the stuggling youth.

Naming : Established in the name of a Graduate College, this college was renamed on July 01, 1982 as 'Dwarika Prasad Vipra Mahavidyalaya' after the name of late Shri Dwarika Prasad Tiwari 'Vipra' who was a well known public literateur of Chhattisgarh and former Chairman, Administration Committee, D.P. Vipra College.

Operation : This college is run by the Graduate College Education Committee, D.P.Vipra PG College, Bilaspur. Presently there are sixteen members in this committee, whose Chairman is Shri Anurag Shukla and the Principal of the college is Dr. Anju Shukla is an Ex-Officio Secretary.

Administration Committee: The management, operation, regulation and control of the college are in the hands of the Administration Committee of the College. According to the Chhattisgarh University act, in the constituted Administration Committee of the college, Shri Anurag Shukla is the Chairman, Dr. Smt. Pratiksha Mairal and Dr. I.P. Gupta are University representatives. Apart from this, the donor members are Shri Rajkumar Agrawal, Shri G. P. Kaushik & Mr. Subhash Mishra. The two teachers representatives are Dr. Vivek Ambalkar and Dr. Smt. Abha Tiwari. Dr. Smt. Anju Shukla is the Principal/Ex-officio Secretary.

The Courses in the College: In the College, undergraduate and post graduate courses are run in Arts, Commerce and Science Faculties. The research centre, for Ph.D in Chemistry, Botany,

English Literature, Economics, ^{Sociology,} and Commerce subjects, is recognized by Atal Bihari Vajpayee University, Bilaspur. In the faculty of Science, there are employment oriented courses like, Microbiology, Bio-technology, Bio-chemistry and BCA, PGDCA, BBA, PGDBM, BMM Home Science is driven.

Students' Number: The student strength in the session 2020-21 is 4568, which is the highest number of students of any college of Bilaspur University. Overall, the attraction of students of the state and other provinces towards this college with 71 professors and 46 employees i.e. 117 personnel has been increasing for getting admission. In the year 2020-21, the number of regular and self-study students in the annual examination was about 9000.

Scholarships: (01) Out of the students studying in this college, more than 60 percent of the students are from rural areas, in which online facility has been provided by the government to the students of Scheduled Castes/Tribes and Backward Classes and Minorities, which is directly deposited in the account of those students. This amount is approximately 10,380000.00 (One crore three lakh eighty thousand rupees).

(02) In the forms of the memory of Smt. Janki Devi Shukla, the regular student who secures the highest marks in M.Sc. Previous (any subject) of the college is awarded Rs. 3000/- in cash as a scholarships by Shri Shyam Narayan Shukla, Engineer, California, America in the name of his own late mother.

(03) In the memory of Mrs. Lalita Sharma, Rs. 2000/- is awarded as scholarship to the regular students who secures the highest marks in M.A. Previous (any subject).

(04) Mr. O.P. Dwivedi scholarship is awarded at the rate of Rs. 200/- per month to a student of Bachelor of Science for ten months.

(05) Shri Ramsnehi Sharma Memorial Scholarship is awarded to the student who secures the highest marks in Post Graduate Commerce. It is given at the rate of Rs. 200/- per month for ten months.

(06) In the memory of late Shri. Ramsahaya and Smt. Tamboli scholarship of the amount of Rs. 1000/- per annum is awarded to the student who secures the highest marks in B.A. Final year by Dr. M.S. Tamboli.

(07) In the memory of late Shri. Prahlad Prasad Shukla (Father-in-law) and late Smt. Mongra Devi Shukla (Mother-in-law) and late Smt. Kanti Devi Shukla (Grand mother-in-law) a scholarship of Rs 1000-1000 is provided annually to each of the players who scores the highest marks and best performance in sports.

(08) The decision has been taken that in the memory of Dr. J. P. Dubey and late Mrs. Santosh Devi Dubey, a special scholarship of Rs. 2000/- will be awarded by Dr. J. P. Dubey, father of Dr. Abha Tiwari, Assistant Professor D. P. Vipra College, Bilaspur to the student who will secure the highest marks B.A. First Year/ M.A. First Semester and who excels in the National Service Scheme (NSS).

(09) Padma Shri Pandit Shyamlal Chaturvedi and Smt. Narmada Devi memorial scholarship of Rs. 1000/- is provide to the student who scores the highest marks in M.A. Previous Hindi Literature per year by Dr. Sushma Sharma, Assistant Professor, Sociology D. P. Vipra college in the holy memory of Padm Shri Pandit Shyam Lal Chaturvedi (Father) who was the founder member of Administration Committee, teacher, senior journalist and litterateur, social worker and the first Chairman, Chhattisgarh Official Language Commission and Smt. Narmada Devi (Mother).

Achievements:

- 1) In the session, 2019-2020 the College celebrated the Golden Jubilee foundation year with gaiety and the programs were conducted throughout the year. In the same line, the country's famous poet Dr. Kumar Vishwas was the Chief Guest of the Golden Jubilee Celebration.
- 2) After the inspection the NAAC team, the college is awarded with A-grade. It is a proud moment for this college to get A-grade after the first round of inspection of the NAAC. Honorable Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh, Mr. Bhupesh Baghel has awarded Global Award to the excellent 'A-Grade' colleges in 2019-2020 and our College is one of those.
- 3) In the year 2019-2020 the National Council for Higher Education Abhiyan (RUSA) has provided Rs. 2.00 crore to the College for basic infrastructure development of the college out of which Rs. 1.00 crore were received in the account of the College. The said work has been handed over to the PWD. The new construction work and the renovation work is to be done by them without any delay. Tender has been issued by the college for the equipment and other materials. In 2019-2020, the college has been granted ISO: 9001:2015.
- 4) Under RUSA 2.0 scheme, equipment worth Rs. 2000000/- was purchased from the grant amount received for the infrastructure development of the college for Arts and Science faculties.
- 5) In the current session about Rs. 32.00 lakh were spent for the construction of the new class rooms and these rooms are now going to be handed over without any delay to the college.

- 6) New study rooms and two halls have been constructed under self-financing scheme over the Sundaram building of the college.
- 7) The construction of reading room and girls' common room above the Library is under process, which will be done through self-financing scheme.
- 8) Building upgradation work has been started. The work order has been issued to the contractor for the construction of the building after the tender from the PWD. The construction work of the building will be started without any delay.
- 9) The college is illuminated with Solar energy, which is completely friendly to the environment. Considering the second stage of NAAC, we have future plans of upgrading and expanding the basic facilities of Campus, Canteen and all Departments. Four Smart classrooms are to be constructed. Herbal Botanical Garden is to be built. College Campus, Canteen and all the Departments are to be equipped with Wi-Fi and Cameras.
- 10) During the global epidemic period of Covid-19, the volunteers of NCC and NSS worked as Corona warriors, which was appreciated by the administration.
- 11) In June 2021, the College provided life-saving essential materials and equipments to the Covid Center/ Local Administration Bilaspur for the treatment of patients infected with Covid-19.

Academic Achievements:

- 1) The Professors of different faculties of the college have sent their applications to work on small research projects to the C.G. Cost, Raipur. This project is under process for approval by the Council of Science and Technology Research.
- 2) The students of the College are continuously gaining the reputation for academic achievements. They are also making the college proud in the fields of NCC/NSS/Red Cross Society and other extra-curricular activities as well.
- 3) The students of the College participated in various educational, sports, social and cultural competitions held at the Inter-college University, State and National level and got remarkable positions.
- 4) First NCC Education Minister Award is received by our NCC In-charge, Shri Ashish Sharma. Along with this, he has got a place in the nine gems declared from the district of Swachchha Mission.
- 5) To keep the records of the College accounts, acknowledgments related to fees from students, daily attendance of students, Professors and employees, training, evaluation reports, special events, College activities and departmental informations organized, establishment of management and departmental information system and Institute Resource Planning Software is under process in the College.
- 6) In the last year, Science and Art Exhibition was organized again, which was organized at the college level. It has been taken to the University level and efforts will be made to organize a State level Science and Arts exhibition in the coming years. In the said program, many intellectuals, social and political workers, including the Vice-Chancellor, appreciated and sent their congratulations for the successful event.

- 7) During this year a three day inter-classes, sports competitions were organized, in which the teachers, staff and students of the college participated enthusiastically and made the event successful.
- 8) Apart from this, 'Jyoti' three year and 'Jyotirmaya' quarterly magazines were published in the session 2019-2020.
- 9) Apart from this, three National Seminars were successfully organized by the College in the subjects of Arts, Science and Commerce. During the period of Covid-19 lockdown, the College achieved success in the academic field by organizing 20 successful webinars. The College also provided technical support to Government Bilasa College, Bilaspur and Government Pataleshwar College, Masturi for organizing their successful webinars. The Principals of both the colleges expressed their gratitude and praised our college.
- 10) At present Seminars, Conferences are being organized by all the departments, in which there is the academic development of the teachers as well as the students.

Library: For the intellectual development and teaching of students, the college has a well-equipped and well-organized library, which is kept in the category of a well-established library under the Bilaspur University area. There are 50000 books in the library, whose value is approximately Rs. 60.00 lakhs. In addition to the general magazines, Indian Research Journals are also ordered. 80 research scholars are registered in various subjects from this research center and so far 148 out of the total registered candidates from this research center till now have been awarded the Ph.D. degree. Our library has taken the form of e-library under Digital India. For this all the procedures have been completed. As this library is being connected to Nflibnet, more than 05.00 lakh Journals and books etc. can be studied directly, which is very useful presently.

Sports: Like last years, this year also the sports students of the college participated in many competitions at Inter-college/University, Divisional, Regional and National level and achieved success in the following competitions. The details of achievements and participation in sports activities of the Sports department in the year 2019-2020 is as follows.

Apart from the above mentioned sports competitions, 74 players have represented the College in the State level and 34 players at the individual level in the Inter-University competitions and National competitions. Notably in which Shrishti Kanskar who captained the Indian team of Net Ball for the tour of Sri Lanka, Vishal Kumar who acted as a refereeship in the ISL football league competition. Shri Javed Khan has been excelling for the past three consecutive years in Santosh Trophy (Senior Nationals). Many of our students, including Akhtar Khan, Shraddha Sonwani, Om Prakash, Tek Lal Purre, Ravindra Thakur etc. have been honoured with State level sports awards. Apart from this, two players have represented India in International level sports, who are in softball and boxing also whose names are Anjali Xalxo and Lewis respectively. The College provides free karate training for the self-defense for its girl students.

NCC/NSS: In the college, the students of National Service Scheme team consisting of two units of two hundred students and one women's unit of 100 girls have achieved prestige at the regional and national level. The State government has given the status of a recognized college to this college. This is a notable participation in the state level camp by the NSS team of the college. Ku. Leena Sahu was selected to go to Manila for an adventure expedition of the University. First year commerce students Kiran Bhoi was selected for the National competition in the University team. The NSS lady In-charge Smt. Reena Tamrakar led the Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh for RDC parade. Mr. Yupesh Kumar led Chhattisgarh team for NIC. 65 Volunteers of NSS ensured their participation in the fight against Corona by standing shoulder to shoulder with the district administration and police administration during the pandemic as Corona warriors. Masks and sanitizers were distributed by NSS volunteers in God gram and people were made aware of social distancing by them.

NCC Unit of the College is counted among the best units of the district. NCC maintains a separate place for its achievements. T.S.C. camp was conducted by Ashish Prajapati in 2019. Vivek Varma and Namrata Deharia raised their flag in Jammu & Kashmir in Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat. NCC discharges the responsibility, its social concerns with full devotion. It also provides contribution in tree plantation, Swachchhata Pakhwada, de-addiction, Gandhi Global Solar Yatra, participation in blood donation camps, to the traffic road safety week and support to the district administration and police administration. The NCC Cadets worked as Corona warriors with District Police for two months tirelessly and met the aspirations of the people in this virtues work. In the coming September, Chhattisgarh is going to honour our Corona Warriors by the Battalion Chief of Madhya Pradesh and the Chief Officers of 7th Battalion.

Red Cross Society: It has already been informed earlier about the blood donation of Red Cross Society. In November 2019, 'Dhanwantri Day' was organized by the Red Cross Society, in which students and Professors were made aware of the benefits of Ayurvedic medicines. The Red Cross Society has been organizing health check-up camps from time to time. In future plans, a plan is proposed to get the regular check-up of blood pressure, dental examination, treatment of diseases etc.


In the year 2019-2020, an attempt was made by the Red Cross Society to reach the Limca Book of World Records by donating 223 units of blood. Hope the College team will be successful in completing this work and get its name registered in the Limca Book of World Records.

In the year 2018-2019, 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 online examinations were conducted by the University keeping in view the infection of Global pandemic Covid-19. Due to which merit list was not issued.

In this way, because of everyone's good will, support and co-operation, this college as started from zero has now movable/immovable assets (according to the market value) of more than Seven Crore Rupees. It is proposed to take a loan from the bank for the expansion of the College building.

Future Plans: The future plans of the college for the coming years as follows:

- (1) Scheme to establish the College as an Autonomus College. For this correspondence has been done with University Grants Commission, New Delhi. There are possibilities of becoming autonomous college soon.
- (2) Scheme to expand the college building so that more new courses can be started.
- (3) Scheme to open the classes of MCA, M.Sc. Bio-technology and Bio-chemistry, B.P.Ed. and B.J.M.C.
- (4) Scheme to obtain permission from the government for teaching Sankrit subject.
- (5) Scheme to expand new rooms/buildings as required.
- (6) Scheme related to purchase of land for playground.
